















WHAT IS THE LEAD PAINT INSPECTION LAW?

P.L. 2021, Ch. 182 is an act passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor concerning certain lead-based paint hazards in residential rental property, associated inspection requirements and establishment of lead-based paint hazards programs. The law tasks DCA with its implementation and DCA has undertaken a multifaceted campaign to address the requirements under P.L. 2021, Ch. 182 and assist municipalities and various interested stakeholders to meet their obligations under the law.

The Department has:

- Developed a comprehensive guidance document in advance of the issuance of regulations (as permitted under the Act) that provides information on the various aspects of the law.
- The regulations were adopted on May 1, 2023.
